Books & Other Resources

Purchase of tuition books are the responsibility of the family. Students who learn instruments that require reeds such as clarinets & saxophones will need to provide their own reeds. It is recommended that students have at least 2 spare reeds in their case at all times. String students are also advised to carry a spare set of strings. The College carries a small quantity of reeds in the Music office, available for purchase by students for \$5 per reed.

Payment

Lesson fees are invoiced by the Instrumental Teacher each term and are to be paid directly to the Instrumental Teacher. If payment is not received by the due date on the invoice, teachers are entitled to cease teaching until such time as payment has been made and/or may add an administrative fee of 5% to the amount owing.

INSTRUMENT HIRE

The College often has spare instruments which we are happy to hire out to families who are either not ready to commit to purchasing an instrument yet, or who require an exceptionally expensive instrument like baritone, euphonium, double bass.
